5. Update the peer review guideline and provide further good practices	<u>1. Peer review Guide and Checklist/ISSAI 5600</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ SC 3 decided not to revise the Checklist only, but rather to revise the PR Guide and Checklist as an integrated whole. ▪ SC 3 agreed on the milestones to be achieved to do so and added them to the action plan (see annex 2). ▪ SC 3 decided to present the revised ISSAI 5600 at INCOSAI 2016. 	Inform PSC on new revision deadline (Chair)
	<u>2. New guidelines on assessing internal/external evaluation of quality assurance and possibilities of widening quality assurance processes by other means than peer reviews</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Proposal of SAI of Morocco in 2011 to develop tools for self assessment or external assessment as a preliminary step for SAIs before being reviewed by a peer ▪ SC 3 had identified risk of overlapping with existing tools and of overstepping its mandate ▪ CBC Steering Committee had suggested at its meeting on 22 September 2011 to check the possibility of extending the activities of SC 3 ▪ SC 3 decided not to ask for an extension of its mandate and to concentrate on the thorough revision of ISSAI 5600 	Inform Steering Committee on decision of SC 3 (Chair)
6. Progress report on SAI performance measurement framework (PMF)	<u>Developing a credible performance measurement tool for SAIs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The INTOSAI Donor Cooperation presented the SAI PMF which has been developed within the KSC's Working Group on the Value and Benefits of SAIs (WGVBS). The SAI PMF is a standardized framework with objective indicators as well as a qualitative performance report that intends to give a holistic, high level assessment of SAI performance against established INTOSAI good practice and enables measurement of progress over time. ▪ Since the last meeting a report on Mapping of SAI Assessment Tools and a Concept Note has been developed. The PMF draft version 2.0 will be disseminated to CBC and its subcommittees on 14 September 2012 for comments. ▪ SC 3 emphasized its willingness to cooperate on the PMF: The German SAI is member of the Task Team for the development of the PMF, the Estonian and Swedish SAIs and the European Court of Auditors participate in the PMF's Reference Group which provides technical support and quality assurance. ▪ SC 3 underlined the different approaches of Peer Review and PMF. The PMF can be used as an internal assessment, external assessment or as a peer review. The qualitative assessment is based on scoring different indicators (on levels 0-4). Like the Peer Review the use of SAI PMF is voluntary.

The progress report has to be submitted by the chair by 14 September 2012. Chair rotation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The German SAI had announced at the 2011 SC 3 meeting that following the regulations of the INTOSAI Handbook for Committees it was willing give up its position as Chair of Sub-committee 3 after having held this position for more than six years ▪ The SAI of the Slovak Republic applied for the position as new Chair of Sub-committee 3 and presented its plans for the Chairmanship. The SC3 members approved the application. 	German SAI will declare its resignation and propose that the Governing Board appoints the SAI of the Slovak Republic as new Chair of Sub-committee 3
